

CUT on the SOLID LINES  
FOLD over the dashed lines  
GLUE or TAPE the ovals together.

**Discovery**  
A tendency toward surprise reveals activity that encourages learning for the sake of creative discovery; promoting a love of learning and doing.

**Accessibility**  
Instruction sets in verbal as well as linear forms to allow literate and non-literate learners an opportunity at success and independence throughout the activities

**Control of Error**

Design features that signal a learner to deviations in their following of an instruction set; allowing for self-correction of errors, in turn raising the crafter's confidence and belief in his or her own capabilities.

**Clarity**  
Clean imagery with minimal flourishes or distractions so as to allow the learner maximum creative freedom and reduce confusion in successfully accomplishing the work
